STUDENT HUB

KOLDING

Located in the heart of Denmark, Kolding is one of the larger cities, known for its strong tradition in business education. Today, it is home to four higher education institutions offering a wide range of academic and extra-curricular opportunities. With a population exceeding 90,000, Kolding municipality strikes a perfect balance — large enough to provide an abundance of social, sports, recreational, and cultural activities, yet small enough to maintain a warm, welcoming atmosphere.

Kolding is situated in one of Denmark's fastest-growing and most economically vibrant regions, making it highly accessible by air, road, and rail. Denmark is renowned for its low crime and accident rates, and Kolding offers students a safe and secure environment. The compact size of the city makes it easy to explore on foot, with most major attractions within walking distance. Cycling, a popular and convenient way to get around, is also well-supported with excellent infrastructure.

Communication is rarely a challenge, as most Danes speak fluent English, making it easy to navigate shops, public transportation, and daily life.

ACCOMMODATION

While students are responsible for securing their own accommodation, finding a place to live in Kolding is generally straightforward. To ensure you find the type of housing you want at the right price, it is essential to apply early. We recommend starting your search at www.studentkolding.dk.

Additionally, several private housing companies in Kolding offer affordable rental options. Be prepared to pay a deposit when renting, and note that most apartments are typically unfurnished. However, there is a wide variety of affordable new and used furniture available. For those seeking furnished rooms, visit www.metropolis-kolding.dk.

LIVING COSTS

It is important to take into account all living costs. This includes travelling to and from Denmark, accommodation, food, and leisure activities. It is cheaper if you are prepared to share an apartment. You should allow approximately 800-1200 Euros monthly to cover all your expenses.

SPORTS AND LEISURE

Kolding is an ideal location for those with an active lifestyle, offering abundant green spaces, numerous sports facilities, and scenic walking and cycling trails. The city hosts an impressive swimming and aquatic center, along with several well-equipped fitness centres. For shopping enthusiasts, the town centre features a variety of stores, while a large shopping mall, complete with a multiplex cinema, is just a 15-minute bus ride away.

BUDDY PROGRAM

The IBA buddies are student volunteers assigned to assist you during your first weeks in Denmark, a period when many things may seem unfamiliar and strange. Prior to your arrival in Kolding, you will be provided your buddy's name and contact information. It is important that you reach out to them and inform them of your arrival date so that they can arrange to meet you at the train or bus station in Kolding. Your buddy will also show you around the campus and offer guidance on practical matters.

WELCOME DAY

On Welcome Day, you will receive practical and valuable information about the teaching and learning processes at the IBA, as well as guidance on the registration process. As part of the experience, you'll also have the opportunity to visit Koldinghus, the medieval castle at the heart of Kolding.

CAMPUS KOLDING

Campus Kolding provides information about student life in Kolding, including practical details about events, discounts, sports activities, and many more. You can also find a Guide to Newcomers on its website.

DANISH CLASSES

You have the opportunity to take free Danish language classes at Sprogskolen Kolding, the public language school conveniently located just across the road from the IBA. They offer Danish lessons twice a week, with afternoon and evening sessions available.

CHINESE CLASSES

With the IBA Confucius Institute, you can take free Chinese language classes at various levels. After completing a semester, you will have an opportunity to participate in a two-week summer camp in Shanghai, China.
